Past recipients of the FPA Fine Arts Scholarships and non-Michigan residents are not eligible to apply. The Friends of Polish Art reserves the right to not award a scholarship(s) should there not be a qualified applicant.

In order to be eligible for an award, this application with all required documentation must be received no later than March 1, 2012 (faxes not accepted). Winners will be notified on or before May 1, 2012. All awards will be made payable to the recipient and to the institution to which he/she is enrolled. You may apply for only one type of scholarship, the Frank Filipek Scholarship or the Lillian & Chester Mitchell FPA Fine Arts Scholarship. You may not apply for two scholarships in a given year.
